The Cardiac Care Unit will be moving into a new area of the hospital to help improve its care and services for local people being treated for heart related illnesses.

By moving the unit into its new location the hospital will be able to make some significant improvements that have been put forward as a result of patient and staff feedback.

Did you know...?

- Heart and circulatory disease is the UK's single biggest killer.
- More than one in three people die from cardiovascular disease, around half of these from coronary heart disease and more than a quarter from a stroke.
- Heart disease rates in and around our local region are sadly above the national average.
- In our region 3805 people were admitted to hospital in 07/08 with Cardiac related illnesses. 429 people were admitted with a heart attack (Acute Myocardial Infarction) and 1536 people were admitted with chest pain.
- In the UK someone has a heart attack every 2 minutes.

This is why we want to make our Cardiac Care Unit something we can all be proud of.
